Note 1:- For the posts of Category No. 3, 4, 9 & 10:- The candidates who had applied earlier in response to advertisements No. **11(4)/2015, 8(5) of 2015, 8(4) of 2015 and 8(6) of 2015** need not apply again as their previous applications for the concerned posts will be considered if they fulfill all the terms & conditions of the advertisements and otherwise found eligible.
